

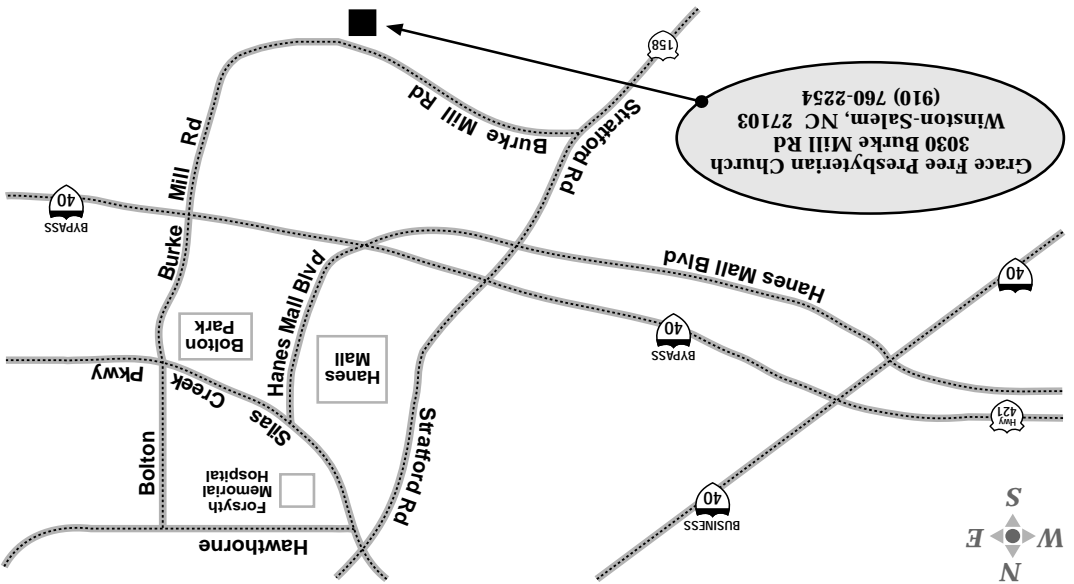
A Word From The Pastor
